Review of the Names of God

ELOHIM: Powerful-Creator God ADONAI: Master-Lord JEHOVAH: Self-Existing One

Today, we study yet another name for God: JEHOVAH-JIREH

God loves to come through for His people But not until they **let go**.

The Call to Abraham

Genesis: 22:1-2

Verse 1: "test": to test completely through a demonstration of stress

Abraham is called by God to face an extreme exam

Abraham's response: Here am I

Verse 2: God's message to Abraham

3 words that scream out to Abraham:

- Take
- Go
- Sacrifice

Total commitment will always be at a cost.

The Choice of Abraham

Genesis: 22:3-10

Abraham's choice (response): no hesitation to obey God

Words in the biblical text which indicate an immediate response:

- "rose"
- "saddled"
- "took"
- "clave" (split)
- "rose up"
- "went"

Delay in obedience almost always turns to disobedience.

The Confession of Abraham

Genesis 22:11-14

Abraham did not hear the ram trying to get out of the thicket until he first obeyed God's command.

The answer to the trial we are facing oftentimes is sitting right next to us.

We will never know – however- until we obey God.

JEHOVAH-JIREH: "The Lord will provide"

Before we will truly know Jehovah-Jireh and experience Him as the God who provides,

We must first obey Him fully.

It's time to put it all on the altar.

Matthew 6:33 – But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.
