I. CONCEPT

II. CHOICE

"bear fruit" = win others to Christ

III. COMPANION

Jesus invites us to follow Him

IV. CONFLICT

And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him. Matthew 4:22

Three Stages of Jesus's Ministry

- 1. Come and See = to observe
- 2. Come and Die = to be fully committed to Christ
- 3. Go and Tell

V. COMMAND

And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. Matthew 4:19
