Jesus quotes Deuteronomy 6:5 and 10:12 – to love the Lord thy God with ALL your heart, soul and might.

Jesus drops 'might' and adds the word 'mind'. Why does He do this?

God's love toward us can be generally summed up in 2 categories:

- 1. He loves us by **providing for us**
- 2. He loves us by sacrificing for us

But how to WE love God?

- 1. We love Him with our body
 - a. By resisting those things that are morally bad
 - b. By witnessing, helping, serving
- 2. We love Him with our soul
 - a. By focusing on things of eternal value (Mark 8:36-37/1 Peter 2:11)

This sermon's focus: **loving the Lord with all your MIND** – how we can keep our mind in a state that is consistent with loving the Lord our God with all our mind, in the midst of so much negativity in the world.

Keeping a mind that pleases God: 3 truths

- 1. I love the Lord with all my mind BY BELIEVING HIM
 - a. Ephesians 1:11-12
 - b. Mark 9:14-24
- 2. I love the Lord with all my mind BY TRUSTING HIM

a. James 2:19

3. I love the Lord with all my mind BY SACRIFICING

- a. Romans 5:8
- b. 2 Corinthians 10:5

One cannot love the Lord with all their mind if they don't first accept Jesus Christ as their Savior.

There are certain facts that one must believe:

- He was born of a virgin
- He was God in the flesh
- He was sinless
- He was crucified
- He rose from the grave
- He will return

It is necessary to believe these facts – but it is insufficient **only** to believe it. Salvation comes when I accept that I am a sinner – and then by faith accept God's gift of salvation

To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them. 2 Corinthians 5:19
