- God gets our attention in **uncertain times**
- He wants us **refocus**
- The current pandemic is **bigger than us**

Let's look at a situation in the disciples' lives that was bigger than they were

Bible text: **Mark 4:35-41**

## 1. The Ship's Pilot (vs. 35-36)

Background:

- The storm took place immediately following a great **day of learning**
- Jesus was **teacher** to the disciples – they had learned about parables
- It was now evening – and Jesus wanted to go to the other side of the **Sea of Galilee** by boat

### A. The Pilot's Direction (vs.35)

Jesus gives direction

### B. The Pilot's Destination (vs.35)

He sets the destination ("unto the other side")

Q: Where are **YOU** going in life?

## 2. The Storm's Peril (vs. 37-38)

Often, the thing that brings the greatest blessing in life is the very thing that brings the greatest storm in life.

**A. The storm hit SUDDENLY (vs.37)**

**B. The storm hit SEVERELY (vs.37)**

## 3. The Savior's Power

**A. The Mastery of His Power (vs.38)**

When the storms of life come, remember the **promises of God**

- **Psalm 37:25**
- **Psalm 34:19**
- **Isaiah 43:2**

**B. The Measure of His Power (vs.39-40)**

**C. The Marvel of His Power (vs.41)**
